Preschool Peer Models

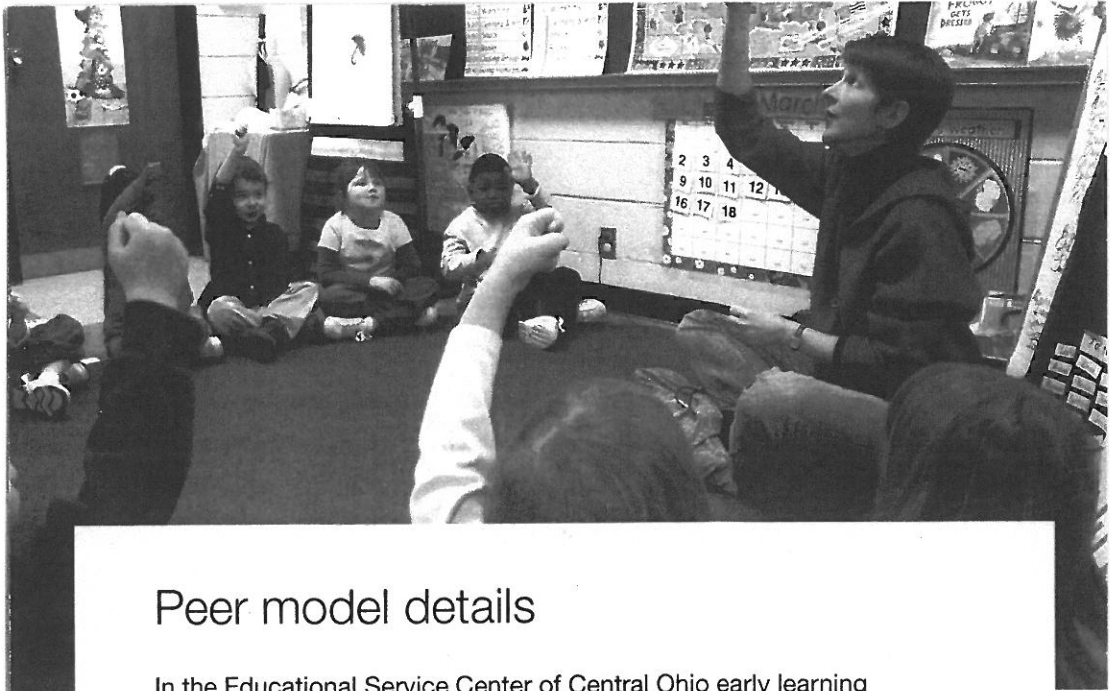


Early Learning Opportunity: Peer models wanted

The Educational Service Center of Central Ohio early learning program is seeking qualified peer models for next school year.

Peer models are needed for each class which includes a maximum of eight preschoolers with a disability.

Each classroom has a licensed Early Childhood/Special Education teacher and a trained para-professional. The programs offer morning or afternoon classes, which are 2.5 hours per session.



Peer model details

In the Educational Service Center of Central Ohio early learning program, a **peer model** is a child who fulfills the following requirements:

- 4 or 5 years of age
- Has appropriate self help skills (ex: toilet trained)
- Has age appropriate speech and language skills
- Plays well with other children
- Follows directions well

The programs offer morning or afternoon classes, which are 2.5 hours per session. Parents must provide their own transportation. A visit will be scheduled upon receipt of complete application packet.

Classrooms are located in Delaware, Franklin and Union counties.
