What makes a fruit a fruit?

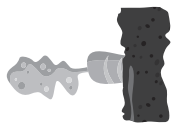
Fruits are generally sweet and have seeds on the inside.

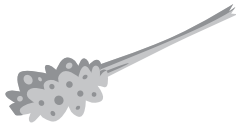
