RICHARD DAUGHERTY REYNOLDSBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION 2024 SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was created for the purpose of honoring the memory of Richard Daugherty. Richard Daugherty died in 1997 while in office as a Board of Education member. He also served a long distinguished tenure as a member of city council and mayor of Reynoldsburg. This scholarship is to be awarded to a worthy Reynoldsburg High school graduating senior to help further his/her education after graduation. The scholarship shall be in the amount of \$2,000 to be awarded from the Reynoldsburg City schools Foundation Account.

The Board of Education President will appoint a committee to select the recipient.

The criteria will include:

- 1. The recipient student will have law, police work, fire dept., social work, education, political science, medicine/nursing, or public service as his/her vocational goal.
- 2. Has earned a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 3. Complete cover page.
- 4. Provide a list of school and community activities, for grades 9-12
- 5. Include a transcript
- 6. Submit an essay stating career goal, GPA, and address why you believe you should receive this scholarship. Also include how the scholarship will be used. The only identification on the essay should be your school ID number

The Committee shall create such other criteria it deems appropriate and it may choose not to award the scholarship every year.

The Cover page/essay must be submitted to your counselor no later than 2 pm Thursday, April 4, 2024.
