Reynoldsburg City Schools Identifies Two Final Candidates for Superintendent

The Board of Education and Stakeholder Groups Will Interview Finalists Monday, May 23, 2022

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio – Two final candidates have been identified by Reynoldsburg City Schools' Board of Education in partnership with the search firm Finding Leaders for the role of Superintendent. The candidates are:

- Dr. Corey Grubbs, Area Superintendent, Columbus City Schools, Columbus, Ohio. He currently leads a region of more than 7,000 students in 19 schools.
- Garilee Ogden, Superintendent, Groveport Madison Local Schools, Groveport, Ohio. She has led the district for the past four years, serving nearly 6,000 students.

"The Board of Education was very pleased with the high level of qualifications of our semi-finalists and found it very difficult to narrow our focus to two final candidates to interview," said Reynoldsburg City Schools Board President Debbie Dunlap. "As we move ahead in this process, we are extremely grateful to our community, staff, parents, and students, who were able to provide input about the qualities needed in the next superintendent of Reynoldsburg City Schools. Together we will find the optimal fit for our students, staff, and Raider community."

"It has been a great experience watching the Reynoldsburg Board of Education work so diligently and collaboratively in their search for the next leader of the District," said Ed Vittardi, consultant for Finding Leaders. "We look forward to assisting the Board with the stakeholder and final interviews. We have been so impressed with the Board's commitment to a thorough process in partnership with the Reynoldsburg community."

Final interviews will be held May 23, 2022 in the Board of Education's Executive Session meeting with Stakeholder Groups from the community and will be facilitated by Finding Leaders. Five candidates were interviewed on May 18 and 19, 2022. One candidate chose to withdraw from the process prior to the scheduled interviews, bringing the number of finalists down one from the original six.
