For the upcoming 2021-22 academic school year, Reynoldsburg City Schools will follow the advice and direction of federal, state and local health organizations.

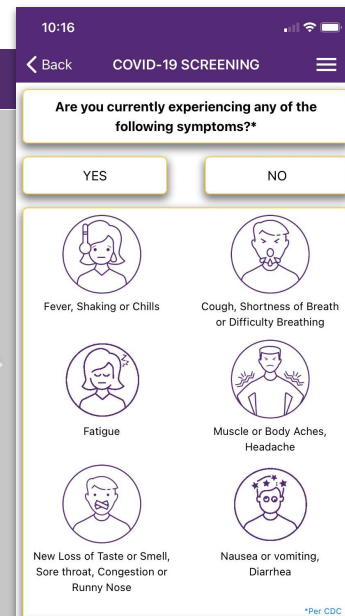
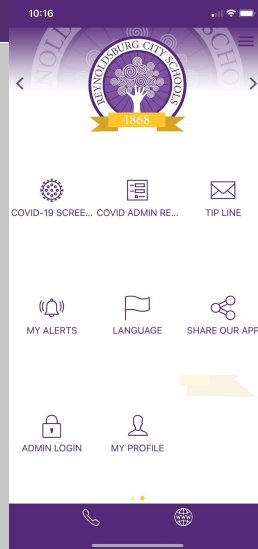


ALL IN PLAN (Begins August 18, 2021)

- All Students Every Day – In Person
- 5 Days a Week
- There is no plan (or legislation) for a virtual learning environment at this time.
- All Pre-K through 12th grade students, teachers and staff will be required to wear a mask indoors during the school day, regardless of vaccination status.
- Masks are also required for everyone who is unvaccinated.

Additional Information and District Efforts:

- Parents must assess student health before school
- Social distancing whenever possible
- Vaccines, if eligible, are strongly recommended
- Continued cleaning of buildings/rooms/surfaces
- Continued hand sanitizing
- Visitors and Volunteers are welcome!
- Attendance taken daily
- Arrival, dismissal and recess will proceed as normal



FACIAL COVERINGS EXPECTATIONS



•Reynoldsburg City Schools will follow the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Ohio Department of Health's guidance for fask mask use in our District. All Pre-K through 12th grade students, teachers and staff will be required to wear a mask indoors during the school day to help to decrease the transmission of the COVID-19 virus and its variants, regardless of vaccination status. Masks are also required for everyone who is unvaccinated.

•In accordance with state law, masks are required on public transportation, including school buses.

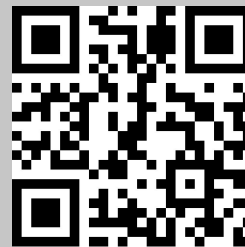
