WHAT IF IT PASSES?

- Full-day Kindergarten District-wide.
- A new Early Learning Center at Graham Road that will utilize historic pieces from the original Hannah Ashton building.
- · A new Middle School.
- Upgrades to electrical and technology systems to accommodate modern learning.
- $\bullet\,$ New flexible and collaborative learning spaces for today's educational models.
- Efficient and consolidated District business offices.
- Permanent Improvement funds to maintain our community's school buildings and facilities into the future.

WHAT IF IT FAILS?

- Without funding for a bond, our facilities will continue to dictate what we
 can and cannot offer our students. Class sizes will continue to increase and
 dollars will be diverted from the classroom to deploy short-term fixes to
 major facility limitations.
- The needs to repair and expand our facilities do not go away with time; rather the fixes will become more costly and urgent.
