

## Materials:

- Game Boards
- Letter Cards
- Game Pieces [Any small object will do, but I like to use craft puffs (quiet) or pencil top erasers (sturdy)].
- Dice
- Star Cards


## Directions:


Begin on the star. Roll a die to move. Choose a letter card from the pile. Read the CVC word created with the board and card. Each time a player passes the star, they collect a star card. The player with the most stars wins.


## Notes:

I use this in small groups and as a literacy station. The consonant cards can be printed for both the initial sound and ending sound boards, but be sure to remove cards such as the 'x' from the initial sounds and the 'y' from the ending sounds.
