



JAN B. YATES ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

Purpose: Jan B. Yates graduated from Reynoldsburg High School in 1965 and received a Masters of Mechanical Engineering from The Ohio State University. He spent most of his professional career at Battelle Memorial Institute where he had 33 U.S. patents and several foreign patents. After retirement, he became a mentor for the Reynoldsburg High School Robotics Team from 2011 to 2020. The purpose of the scholarship is to help a member of the robotics team to continue their education in any discipline of engineering as a tribute to his dedication and love of educating others.

Amount: \$2000 – Funding provided by friends and family. Payment to be made to the College/University of choice. In event of applicant receiving full scholarship support from the university, payment to the individual to support educational expenses is allowed.

Number of scholarships to be awarded: 1 scholarship per year

Duration: Scholarships will be award in 2021, 2022, and 2023

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) Accepted to a 4-year college/university or equivalent
- 2) Major in Engineering (any discipline)
- 3) GPA of at least 3.0
- 4) Graduating Senior from Reynoldsburg High School
- 5) Current member of Reynoldsburg High School Robotics team
- 6) Must have spent at least 2 years on the Reynoldsburg High School Robotics team.
- 7) Complete application received by deadline

Selection: Applications will be reviewed by the Yates family and one individual will be selected. Funds will be disbursed from the Reynoldsburg Board of Education account.

Submission: Completed applications should be submitted as directed by Reynoldsburg High School for local scholarships.
