

Tina Thomas-Manning Scholarship

Scholarship Criteria

The Tina Thomas-Manning Scholarship will be awarded to graduating high school students in the class of 2021. Each recipient will receive a one-time award in the amount of \$1000. There are multiple awards available. Applicants must demonstrate:

- Evidence of hard work to overcome obstacles
- Academic success and extracurricular success in high school
- A commitment of service to others

The application must include all required documents and must be received by April 12, 2021.

Required Documentation

An application is considered “complete” when it is accompanied by the following documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. **Personal Narrative** - A written statement - 500-word minimum, two-page maximum
 - Please discuss your academic career and extracurricular activities and provide examples of hard work, successes, challenges, and resilience you experienced while working toward your goals. Additionally, please provide information on your commitment to the service of others.
2. **Letters of Recommendation** - Each applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from a high school principal, teacher, guidance counselor, staff member, and/or a representative of a community service program with which you have been active.

Please address the following:

- Relationship to the applicant
 - Applicant’s strengths
 - Length of time acquainted with the applicant
 - Examples that elaborate on the applicant’s academic achievements, evidence of a strong work ethic, and commitment to serving others
3. **Proof of College/University Enrollment for Fall 2021** - To be submitted before the award is made payable.
