

The Missy Borgman Scholarship Application
2020-2021 Academic Year

The Missy Borgman Scholarship was established in the summer of 2018 by the Grove City Chamber Singers to honor the memory of this outstanding singer member of over seventeen years, who lost her battle with cancer on May 11, 2018. During her tenure with the GCCS, Mrs. Borgman demonstrated not only high levels of musicianship, but many personal qualities that earned high regard from everyone who knew her. To continue this legacy, the GCCS will be presenting an award to two graduating seniors (one from Reynoldsburg High School and one from the high schools in Grove City.) The amount of each scholarship to be given this year is \$500. The selection committee for the applicants consists of five members of Chamber Singers who possess the qualifications to select appropriate recipients.

Interested applicants must have these qualifications:

- 1) A GPA of 3.4 or higher (please enclose an official high school transcript with this application)
- 2) Four years of enrollment in a high school choral ensemble

***Please note: Your intended college major does not have to be related to music to be considered for this award, but it must be used in the 2021-2022 academic year. The scholarship will be sent directly to the college of enrollment.**

If you meet these qualifications and are interested in being considered for this scholarship, please complete this application and return it to your high school choral instructor by March 3, 2021. (Arrangements will be made to pick up scholarship applications March 5 from each director.)
